Course Description

This year-long course in marching concepts, halftime show and in-door pageantry is offered to letter carriers, majorettes, rifle team members, and tall flag corps. Members participate in all home varsity football games and state-wide band reviews and competitions, parades and theme park concerts and winter color guard competitions.

Grading Scale

Each student begins each semester at zero (0) points. As the grading period progresses, the student will have opportunities to gain points towards their final grade. Final grades will reflect the percentage of points earned from the total points available.

Benchmarks (Performances)

All performances = 1000 points

Class Participation (Rehearsals)

100 points for class participation during scheduled events.
Participation includes: following class rules,
working on routine during rehearsal,
using proper equipment assigned by Auxiliary Staff,
and following dress code rules.

Writing Assignments

Points for writing assignments will be assigned by Mr. Capote.
